## 13 Environmental Responsibility

#### 13.1 Environmental Permits and Compliance with Regulations

Brytec complies with all **applicable environmental laws and regulations**, including those that:

- regulate the use or restriction of certain substances,
- define labeling requirements for recycling and disposal.

All required **environmental permits and registrations** are obtained, kept up to date, and maintained. Operating and reporting obligations are **strictly followed**.

Brytec takes into account **resource efficiency and ecological aspects** in cooperation with business partners, suppliers, and customers. If employees identify relevant **ecological issues**, they may report them informally via email to the **ESG team**.

# 13.2 Responsible Use of Natural Resources and Prevention of Environmental Pollution

The **Brytec Group** is committed to **avoiding or reducing all types of waste**. This includes in particular:

- · Reducing water consumption,
- Reducing energy consumption,
- Minimizing the use of fossil fuels, minerals, and other raw materials,
- Implementing energy efficiency measures and sustainable resource management.

The use of **renewable energy sources**—such as **photovoltaic systems**—is promoted to **replace non-renewable energy sources**.

Brytec also takes **measures to reduce environmental pollution**, particularly with regard to **CO**<sub>2</sub> and greenhouse gas emissions. This is achieved by:

- Reducing travel,
- Optimizing production facilities and business processes.

### 13.3 Handling of Hazardous Substances

Employees must **immediately inform their supervisors** if they detect or are informed about the **release of such substances**. Additionally, they must inform the department head or local management, as well as the **ESG team**.

#### **13.4 Waste Management**

Brytec is committed to implementing systematic waste management to identify, reduce, and properly dispose of or recycle solid waste in an environmentally responsible manner.

## 13.5 Further Development of Environmental Measures

Brytec recognizes the **impact of its business activities on the environment** and actively promotes **sustainable processes**.

All **Brytec companies** are expected to establish an **appropriate environmental management system** in accordance with the **ISO 14001 standard**.

Brytec is committed to the **continuous improvement of its sustainability performance** and expects the same from its suppliers, particularly in the **implementation of environmental measures**. Suppliers are evaluated based on **ESG (Environmental, Social, Governance)** criteria.



#### 13.6 Animal Welfare

The **responsible treatment of living creatures** is a fundamental value of Brytec. Compliance with **national and international animal welfare regulations** is a matter of course.

Brytec is committed to:

- maintaining **high animal welfare and traceability standards** in its business processes,
- providing special protection for endangered species,
- and strictly rejecting any form of animal cruelty.

## 13.7 Biodiversity, Land Use, and Deforestation

Brytec actively supports the **protection and restoration of biodiversity**, with a special focus on **forests and land use**.

Brytec ensures that its business activities:

- do not involve the conversion of natural forests or unsustainable deforestation,

#### 13.8 Protection of Water and Soil

- prevention of desertification and soil erosion,
- biodiversity conservation,
- ensuring healthy food production and protecting human health.

Brytec implements management systems for measuring, reducing, and continuously improving environmental performance across the entire supply chain.

In addition, Brytec commits to avoiding excessive water consumption that:

- harms human health.
- restricts access to clean water or sanitation,
- negatively impacts natural resources needed for food production.

#### **13.9 Noise Emissions**

Brytec is committed to **reducing noise emissions** at its production sites.

Measures to reduce noise include:

- Reducing noise levels from delivery traffic from external suppliers,
